Equinox presentation and demo:

Version 1.4 is coming out now. Version 2.0 will be out in May. Members were encouraged to join mailing lists. Some highlights:

Patrons or staff can create "bookbags" – favorites lists, Summer Reading Club lists, etc. Vendors that provide enhanced content for bibliographic records: Syndetic Solutions, Content Café and Book Letters

Libraries can add links or announcements to the front page.

Uncataloged items can be checked out (they are called pre-cataloged)

Record "buckets" allow batch changes.

Mapping documents: Every library will fill out these forms according to their own policies and collection parameters. It is possible in Evergreen to have different loan durations for a single item type.

Grant discussion: NTRLS will hire someone to administer the Consortium if we get the grant. Contract labor vs. a full-time employee was discussed. After some discussion, Leanna Cowan moved that we proceed to apply for the grant. Geoff Sams seconded and the motion carried.

Consortium website: NTRLS will ask TSLAC to host a Plinkit website for the Consortium.

The need for a Consortium logo was expressed.
